

Courageous Congregations Collaborative [C3]

2025-26 Michigan Cohorts | September 2025 - May 2026

WHAT IS C3? C3 is an initiative developed by Texas Methodist Foundation which shares and equips teams to use five muscles that congregations need to strengthen and flex in this ministry season. Engaging these five muscles will support disciples in cultivating thriving congregations who share the Good News and love of Jesus. Thanks to a grant from the Lilly Endowment and investment by the United Methodist Foundation of Michigan, C3 Michigan cohorts bring teams from Michigan together to learn, experience, and flex the five muscles in their contexts. The TMF, UMF MI, and C3 team believe people participating in C3 and using these muscles as they discern God's movement and call in the life of their congregation will cultivate vibrant communities of faithful and fruitful disciples of Jesus.

What will we do? The pastor and four laity from each congregation gather together for an in person, on-site regional learning journey, engage in online 1.5 hour sessions, develop and present a ministry initiative emerging from the five muscles, and receive three months of coaching to support and encourage the team through implementing the ministry initiative.

C3 was a meaningful and eye-opening journey for our team at Orchard. Rather than focusing on tasks or action plans, the process encouraged us to look inward—to reflect deeply and honestly.
